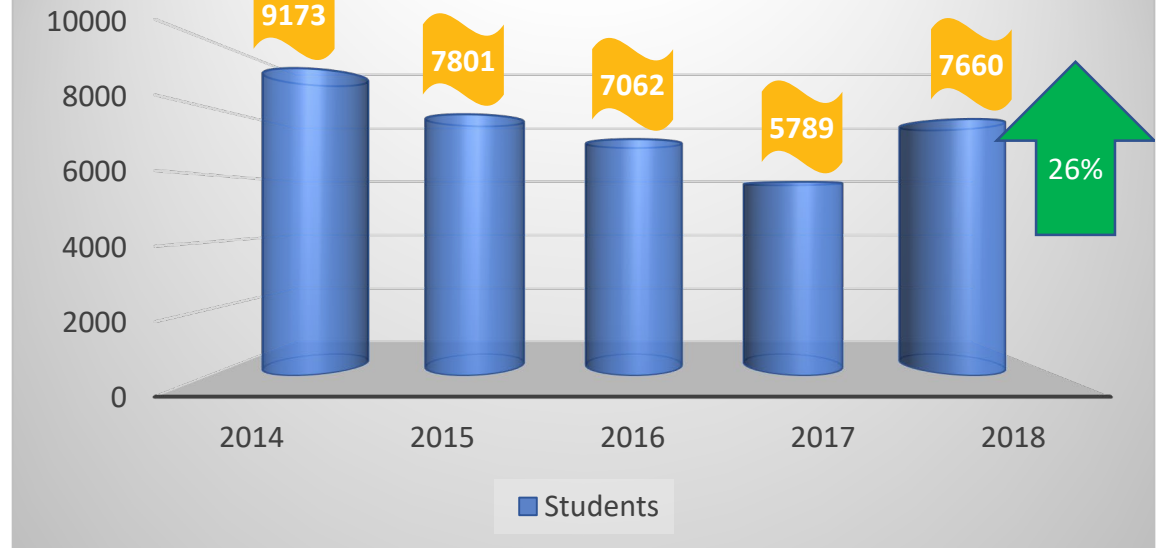

Risk Management

RISK	INTERVENTION(S)
Loss of books	Book anti-theft devices are installed at each library with security officers stationed close to the gates
Loss of cash	Improve the library financial controls to prevent loss
Loss of University Property	Installation of secure access control system
Library structure no longer relevant	The proposed organisational structure was completed and waiting for institutional approval
No knowledge about staff productivity	Implementation of the institutional performance management tool. Managers on level 7 signed performance agreements for the year. Evaluations to be done in 2019
Narrow collection of information resources	Lobbying the institution to fund libraries from teaching input and output units, tuition fees and research outputs as intended by the DHET in providing the subsidy for core academic activities.
Collection not properly measured	Tools for measuring the collection has been purchased. Workshops held with the librarians and heads of libraries
